This agreement, made this thirteenth day of January in the year eighteen hun-
 dred and twenty nine, between Thomas ap. L. Jones, of the first part, Thomas B. Balch
 of the second part, John Will Carter of the third part and Elizabeth Carter of the
 fourth part, witnesses that whereas the said Jones and Balch in right of their wives
 and the said John Will and Elizabeth in their own rights, are co-owners in reversion
 of the slaves late the property of Charles B. Carter dec^d which were allotted to Mrs.
 Ann B. Carter now Ann B. Maffitt as her dowry, and are desirous of purchasing
 the said dowry right about to be sold, in order to divide them speedily and con-
 veniently in consideration of the premises, and with the intention to carry said
 views into effect, the said parties interchangeably agreed with each other, that they
 will through a common agent, purchase the dowry right in said slaves as their
 joint property, and that when the said purchase shall have been completed, they
 will appoint each, an agent or referee to divide the said slaves into four equal
 parts as nearly as practicable, and to assign one part to each of the parties hereto, &
 in the event of the four referees thus named not being able to agree on such division
 they and themselves to nominate and choose a fifth individual to act as an um-
 pire, whose decision shall be binding upon the parties, and the said parties to
 this agreement bind themselves to furnish each, one fourth part of the money ne-
 cessary to pay for the said dowry right, and they engaged and stipulated with each
 other to abide by and be governed by the determination of said referees or said um-
 pire as the case may be
